<p>Clarifying Vocabulary Clarify the meaning of anything in the text that you didn't know.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What do you think the word means? • Can you find the meaning of the word? • Can you use it in a sentence? 	<p>Predicting Make a prediction about your book.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What might happen next in the book? • How might the problem in the book be solved? • How do you think the book might end? 	<p>Summarising In your own words explain something that has happened in the book.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Summarise what you have already read • What are the important ideas/events in this book? • What was the problem in the book and how was it solved? • Tell me what happened in the book in order
<p>Comparing What connections can you make between the book and yourself, the book or the world.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You: Does something in this book remind you of something in your life • Text: what connections can you make between this book and another one you've read? • World: What type of connections can you make from this book? 	<p>Questioning Ask some questions based on what you have read.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What do you wonder about this book? • What questions could you ask one of the characters? • Do you have any questions for the author or illustrator of this book? • What did the author do to make this book funny/sad/interesting • Why did the character feel the way they did? What made them feel that way? 	<p>Analyse Have a deeper look at some of the features of the text. What do you notice?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What was the purpose of writing this book? • Can you name and notice anything the author has done that is interesting? • What is the relationship between the setting and the plot? • What genre is the book? (narrative, information, persuasive, procedure) How do you know? • How did the illustrations support the text?
